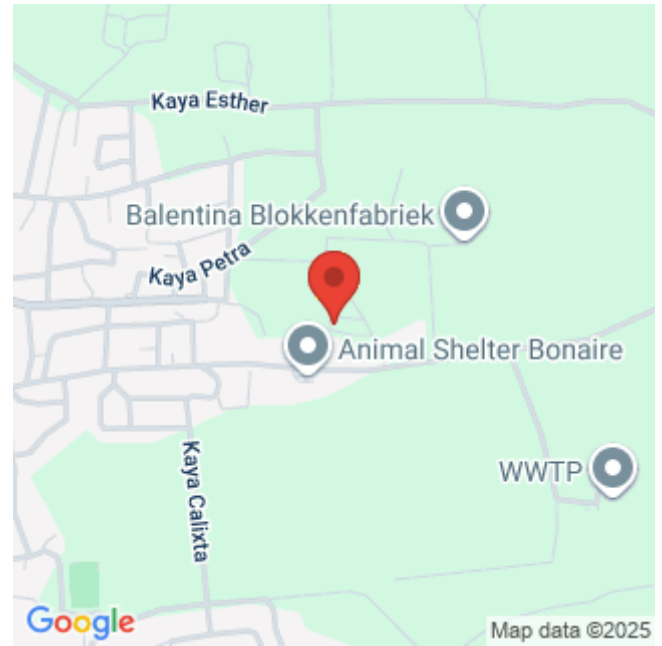

Features

There is no building obligation on these plots. You can choose to purchase the land now and build at a later time. You are also free to have your own design constructed by a contractor of your choice, as long as it complies with the applicable building regulations.

Public facilities

At Oud Lagoen, the cultural and historical significance of the location has been taken into consideration. The characteristic Tanki will be preserved and integrated with a playground. The entire neighborhood features brick paving and street lighting.
